

Rosh Chodesh Head of the month

Numbers 10:10 'Also in the day of your gladness, in your appointed feasts, and at the beginning of your months, you shall blow the trumpets over your burnt offerings and over the sacrifices of your peace offerings; and they shall be a memorial for you before your God: I am the Lord your God."

Ta'anit Esther (Esther's fast)

Esther 9:27-28 'the Jews established and imposed it upon themselves and their descendants and all who would join them, that without fail they should Purim 14 of Adar celebrate these two days every year, according to the written instructions and according to the prescribed time, that these days should be remembered and kept throughout every generation, every family, every province, and every city, that these days of Purim should not fail to be observed among the Jews, and that the memory of them should not perish among their descendants.'

Bechirat HaSeh - Picking the Lamb - 10 of Aviv



Exodus 12:3 'Speak to all the congregation of Israel, saying: 'On the tenth of this month every man shall take for himself a lamb, according to the house of his father, a lamb for a household. '

Zechariah 9:9 "Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout aloud, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, your king is coming to you; righteous and having salvation is he, humble and mounted on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey.

Korban haPesach - Pesach Sacrifice - 14 of Aviv

Erev Pessach Deuteronomy 16:1-2 "Observe the month of Abib, and keep the Passover to the Lord your God, for in the month of Abib the Lord your God brought you out of Egypt by night. Therefore you shall sacrifice the Passover to the Lord your God, from the flock and the herd, in the place where the Lord chooses to put His name.'

Pesach Exodus 12.8-14 Then they shall eat the flesh on that night; roasted in fire, with 15 to 21 - Aviv unleavened bread and with bitter herbs they shall eat it. Do not eat it raw, nor boiled at all with water, but roasted in fire—its head with its legs and its entrails. You shall let none of it remain until morning, and what remains of it until morning you shall burn with fire. And thus you shall eat it: with a belt on your waist, your sandals on your feet, and your staff in your hand. So you shall eat it in haste. It is the Lord's Passover. 'For I will pass through the land of Egypt on that night, and will strike all

the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I am the Lord. Now the blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you are. And when I see the blood, I will pass over you; and the plague shall not be on you to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt. 'So this day shall be to you a memorial; and you shall keep it as a feast to the Lord throughout your generations. You shall keep it as a feast by an everlasting ordinance.

Shabbat - Weekly Celebration - A Statute Forever



Leviticus 23:3 "Six days shall work be done, but the seventh day is a Sabbath of solemn rest, a holy convocation. You shall do no work on it; it is the Sabbath of the Lord in all your dwellings.'

Rosh haShana - Head of the Year



Exodus 12:2 "This month shall be your beginning of months; it shall be the first month of the year to you. '

Yom haAliyah - Aliyah Day - Return of the Jews to the Land of our forefathers 10 of Aviv



Ezekiel 39:27-28 'When I have brought them back from the peoples and gathered them out of their enemies' lands, and I am hallowed in them in the sight of many nations, then they shall know that I am the Lord their God, who sent them into captivity among the nations, but also brought them back to their land, and left none of them captive any longer.'

Omer Reshit First fruits 17 of Aviv



Leviticus 23.9-11 And the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, "Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: 'When you come into the land which I give to you, and reap its harvest, then you shall bring a sheaf of the firstfruits of your harvest to the priest. He shall wave the sheaf before the Lord, to be accepted on your behalf; on the day after the Sabbath the priest shall wave it.

1 Corinthians 15:20-21 "But in fact Christ has been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. For as by a man came death, by a man has come also the resurrection of the dead."

Yom haShoah -Holocaust Remembrance Day



Ezekiel 37:11-12 'Then He said to me, "Son of man, these bones are the whole house of Israel. They indeed say, 'Our bones are dry, our hope is lost, and we ourselves are cut off!' Therefore prophesy and say to them, 'Thus says the Lord Go : "Behold, O My people, I will open your graves and cause you to come up from your graves, and bring you into the land of Israel.'


Yom haAtzma'ut - Israel Independence Day

Yom T'ruah - Day of Trumpets - 1 of Ethanim



Leviticus 23:24 "Speak to the children of Israel, saying: 'In the seventh month, on the first day of the month, you shall have a sabbath-rest, a memorial of blowing of trumpets, a holy convocation.'

Sukkot - Tabernacles - 15 to 21 of Ethanim



Deuteronomy 16:10-11 'Then you shall keep the Feast of Weeks to the Lord your God with the tribute of a freewill offering from your hand, which you shall give as the Lord your God blesses you. You shall rejoice before the Lord your God, you and your son and your daughter, your male servant and your female servant, the Levite who is within your gates, the stranger and the fatherless and the widow who are among you, at the place where the Lord your God chooses to make His name abide.'

Shiv'a beOctober -In memory of the victims of the black sabbath on October 7th



Joel 2:17-18 'Let the priests, who minister to the Lord, Weep between the porch and the altar; Let them say, "Spare Your people, O Lord, And do not give Your heritage to reproach, That the nations should rule over them. Why should they say among the peoples, 'Where is their God?' "Then the Lord will be zealous for His land, And pity His people.'

Yom Herzl - Day in memory of the Father of modern Zionism - Theodor Herzl 10 of Ziv



Zechariah 9:13 'For I have bent Judah, My bow, Fitted the bow with Ephraim, And raised up your sons, O Zion, Against your sons, O Greece, And made you like the sword of a mighty man."

Yom Yerushalaym - 28 of Ziv - Jerusalem Day is an Israeli national holiday commemorating the reunification of Jerusalem and the establishment of Israeli control over the Old City in June 1967.

> Psalms 122:2-3 'Our feet have been standing Within your gates, O Jerusalem! Jerusalem is built as a city that is compact together,'

Tish'a B'av – 9th of Av is a fast day that commemorates the destruction of both the First Temple and Second Temple in Jerusalem, which occurred about 655 years apart, but on the same Hebrew calendar date.



Lamentations 1:4 'The roads to Zion mourn Because no one comes to the set feasts. All her gates are desolate; Her priests sigh, her virgins are afflicted, and she is in bitterness.'

Yom Kippur – Day of Atonement - 10 of Ethanim



Hebrews 9:11-12 'But Messiah came as High Priest of the good things to come, with the greater and more perfect tabernacle not made with hands, that is, not of this creation. Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption.'

Shmini Atzeret - The Eighth day of Assembly - 22 of Ethanim



Revelation 21:1-2 'Now I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away. Also there was no more sea. Then I, John, saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.'

Hanukkah - Feast of Dedication - 25 of Kislev



2 Maccabees 10. 5, 8 They rededicated the Temple on the twenty-fifth day of the month of Kislev, the same day of the same month on which the Temple had been desecrated by the Gentiles. Everyone agreed that the entire Jewish nation should celebrate this festival each year.
