Rosh Hashanah = Head of the Year (1st of Aviv) - 'Adonai spoke to Moshe and Aharon in the land of Egypt; he said, "You are to begin your calendar with this month; it will be the first month of the year for you.' **Sh'mot (Exo) 12:1-2**

Erev = Beginning of a new day from sundown


Shabbat = Weekly Celebration, Perpetual Statute - 'Work is to be done on six days; but the seventh day is a Shabbat of complete rest, a holy convocation; you are not to do any kind of work; it is a Shabbat for Adonai, even in your homes.' **Vayikra (Lev) 23:3**

Bechirat haSeh = Picking the Lamb (10th of Aviv) - "Speak to all the assembly of Isra'el and say, 'On the tenth day of this month, each man is to take a lamb or kid for his family, one per household'" **Sh'mot (Exo) 12:3**

Yom HaAliyah = Day of Aliyah (return of the Jewish people to the land of their ancestors) (10th of Aviv) - 'This will be after I have brought them back from the peoples and gathered them out of their enemies' lands, thereby being consecrated through them in the sight of many nations. Then they will know that I am Adonai their God, since it was I who caused them to go into exile among the nations, and it was I who regathered them to their own land. I will leave none of them there any more, ' **Yechezk'el (Ezk) 39:27-28**

Korban = Sacrifice (14th of Aviv)

Passover (15th to 22nd of Aviv) - "Observe the month of Aviv, and keep Pesach to Adonai your God; for in the month of Aviv, Adonai your God brought you out of Egypt at night. You are to sacrifice the Pesach offering from flock and herd to Adonai your God in the place where Adonai will choose to have his name live. ' **D'varim (Deu) 16:1-2**

Omer Reshit = Firstfruits (17th of Aviv) - 'Adonai said to Moshe, "Tell the people of Isra'el, 'After you enter the land I am giving you and harvest its ripe crops, you are to bring a sheaf of the firstfruits of your harvest to the cohen. He is to wave the sheaf before Adonai, so that you will be accepted; the cohen is to wave it on the day after the Shabbat. ' **Vayikra (Lev) 23:9-11**

Yom HaShoah = Holocaust Remembrance Day (26th of Aviv) - "Then he said to me, "Human being! These bones are the whole house of Isra'el; and they are saying, 'Our bones have dried up, our hope is gone, and we are completely cut off.' Therefore prophesy; say to them that Adonai Elohim says, 'My people! I will open your graves and make you get up out of your graves, and I will bring you into the land of Isra'el.'" **Yechezk'el (Ezk) 37:11-12**

Rosh Chodesh = Head of the Month "Also on your days of rejoicing, at your designated times and on Rosh-Hodesh, you are to sound the trumpets over your burnt offerings and over the sacrifices of your peace offerings; these will be your reminder before your God. I am Adonai your God." **B'midbar (Num) 10:10**

Yom HaZikaron - Day of Remembrance of those who died in the Wars in Israel (Day 2 of 2nd Month)- 'I will pay my vows to Adonai in the presence of all his people. From Adonai's point of view, the death of those faithful to him is costly.' **Tehillim (Psa) 116:14-15**

Yom HaAtzmaut = Israel Independence Day (Day 3 of 2nd Month) - 'Who ever heard of such a thing? Who has ever seen such things? Is a country born in one day? Is a nation brought forth all at once? For as soon as Tziyon went into labor, she brought forth her children.' **Yesha'yahu (Isa) 66:8**

Yom Herzl = Day in Memory of the Father of Zionism Theodor Herzl (Day 10 of 2nd Month) - 'For I have bent Y'hudah as my bow and made Efrayim its arrow. I will rouse your sons, Tziyon, and make you like a warrior's sword against your sons, Greece.'" **Z'kharyah (Zec) 9:13**

Pesach Sheni = Second Passover (Day 14 of Month 2) - 'Adonai said to Moshe, "Tell the people of Isra'el, 'If any of you now or in future generations is unclean because of a corpse, or if he is on a trip abroad, nevertheless he is to observe Pesach. But he will observe it in the second month on the fourteenth day at dusk. They are to eat it with matzah and maror, ' **B'midbar (Num) 9:9-11**

Yom Yerushalayim = Jerusalem Day - Reunification and Israeli Control over the Old City from 1967 (Day 28 of Month 2) - 'Our feet were already standing at your gates, Yerushalayim. Yerushalayim, built as a city fostering friendship and unity.' **Tehillim (Psa) 122:2-3**

Shavuot = Pentecost (6th of the 3rd Month) - 'You are to observe the festival of Shavu'ot [weeks] for Adonai your God with a voluntary offering, which you are to give in accordance with the degree to which Adonai your God has prospered you. You are to rejoice in the presence of Adonai your God – you, your sons and daughters, your male and female slaves, the L'vi'im living in your towns, and the foreigners, orphans and widows living among you – in the place where Adonai your God will choose to have his name live. ' **D'varim (Deu) 16:10-11**

Her gateways are all deserted, her cohanim are groaning, her unmarried girls are grieving – how bitter it is for her!' **Eikhah (Lam) 1:4**

Yom T'ruah = Day of Trumpets (Day 1 of Month 7) - Leviticus 23:24 ““Tell the people of Isra’el, ‘In the seventh month, the first of the month is to be for you a day of complete rest for remembering, a holy convocation announced with blasts on the shofar. ' **Vayikra (Lev) 23:24**

Yom Kippur = Day of Atonement (Day 10 of Month 7) - 'But when the Messiah appeared as cohen gadol of the good things that are happening already, then, through the greater and more perfect Tent which is not man-made (that is, it is not of this created world), he entered the Holiest Place once and for all. And he entered not by means of the blood of goats and calves, but by means of his own blood, thus setting people free forever. ' **Messianic Jews (Heb) 9:11-12**

Sukkot = Tabernacles (Days 15 to 21 of Month 7) - “You are to keep the festival of Sukkot for seven days after you have gathered the produce of your threshing-floor and winepress. Rejoice at your festival – you, your sons and daughters, your male and female slaves, the L’vi’im, and the foreigners, orphans and widows living among you. Seven days you are to keep the festival for Adonai your God in the place Adonai your God will choose, because Adonai your God will bless you in all your crops and in all your work, so you are to be full of joy!' **D'varim (Deu) 16:13-15**

Shmini Atzeret = Assembly of the Eighth Day - (Day 22 of the 7th Month) - *“But on the fifteenth day of the seventh month, when you have gathered the produce of the land, you are to observe the festival of Adonai seven days; the first day is to be a complete rest and the eighth day is to be a complete rest. ’ Vayikra (Lev) 23:39*

Hanukkah = Feast of Dedication (25th of the 9th month to the 3rd of the 10th month) - “They rededicated the Temple on the twenty-fifth day of the month of Kislev, the same day of the same month on which the Temple had been desecrated by the Gentiles. The happy celebration lasted eight days, like the Festival of Shelters, and the people remembered how only a short time before, they had spent the Festival of Shelters wandering like wild animals in the mountains and living in caves. But now, carrying green palm branches and sticks decorated with ivy, they paraded around, singing grateful praises to him who had brought about the purification of his own Temple. Everyone agreed that the entire Jewish nation should celebrate this festival each year.” **2 Maccabees 10.5-8**

Ta'anit Ester = Fast of Esther (Day 13 of Month 12 or Month 13 in leap years)

Purim (Day 14 of Month 12 or 13) - 'the Jews resolved and took upon themselves, their descendants and all who might join them that without fail they would observe these two days in accordance with what was written in [this letter] and at the appointed time, every year; and that these days would be remembered and observed throughout every generation, every family, every province and every city; and that these days of Purim would never cease among the Jews or their memory be lost by their descendants.' **Ester (Est) 9:27-28**

Shushan Purim = Purim is celebrated in the capital Jerusalem as it was in the capital Shushan in Persia.
